T+1 Legal and Regulatory Working Group

Minutes of Jan. 19, 2023 meeting

Pending T1-LRWG Approval

Jamie Anderson chaired the meeting and welcomed the attendees. Attendees were requested to indicate their name and firm; those telephoning in to the video meeting were requested to email Jamie or Keith to confirm their attendance.

1. Approval of the Dec. 15, 2022 meeting minutes

The minutes were approved.

2. Matters arising from the Dec. 15, 2022 meeting minutes

In the previous meeting, there was an action item concerning whether the U.S. Industry Steering Committee¹ has a T+1 legal and regulatory issues log (similar to that done for T+2 by a U.S. law firm)² and whether the U.S. T+1 Asset List has been reviewed by DTCC.³

Tasneem Novak (DTCC) advised that queries have been made on these two questions to the depository side of DTCC and she will update the LRWG accordingly.

3. LRWG feedback on IIROC proposed Rule amendments

Jamie inquired as to whether the LRWG had any feedback on the IIROC proposed Rule amendments at this time. There were no comments on the proposed amendments.

4. CCMA Comment Letter - Proposed Amendments to NI 24-101 (ITMS) Proposed Changes to CP 24-101 ITMS⁴

Jamie referred to the draft comment letter included in the LRWG materials. The draft was previously presented to the OWG on January 12, 2024 for its comments on the form of communication. As of the date of the LRWG meeting, no comments had been received.

There are two primary points being made within the draft comment letter.

The first point pertains to the CSA proposed cut off time of 9:00 p.m. for the affirmation of institutional trades. The letter reflects the decision recommended by the OWG and approved by the T1SC - in order to maximize the number of trades settling in the overnight CDS settlement cycle, 3:59 AM on T+1 is a better option.

The second point is in regard to the proposed quarterly data collection points from CDS. The draft letter recommends the following times: 4:00 PM on Trade Date (market close), 8:00 PM on Trade Date (the best practice to have trades entered), Midnight on Trade Date, 3:59 AM on Trade Date +1 (proposed deadline for affirmation), noon on Trade Date +1 (deadline for matching), 4:00 PM on Trade Date +1

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(payment exchange), and everything after Trade Date +1. These data points not only reflect a tracking for T+1 but will also provide data points for a potential move to T+0 in future.

Jamie referred to the CSA Staff Notice 81-335 – *Investment Fund Settlement Cycles* ("Notice") and asked whether it was intentional that the term "mutual fund" was used rather than "investment fund" in the Notice. The OSC replied it was intentional; if there were concerns in respect to the Notice, it is expected that commenters would use the NI 24-101 comment process.

Jamie requested that any feedback on the letter be sent as soon as possible as the T1SC meeting is set for January 24, 2023.

5. Issue Log LRWG29-Securities Lending

Issue Log LRWG-029 - Securities Lending Agreements was tabled with the LRWG for its recommendation for closure by T1SC. The global Master Lending Agreements do not reflect a specific settlement date and thus modification is not required.

CCMA members should however review their securities lending agreements to see if any changes for T+1 are required.

There were no objections raised by the LRWG to closing the log.

6. Other Business

There was no other business raised.
